

MALT BEVERAGE PERMITS. There being no protests entered, the Commissioners granted renewals of Retail Malt Beverage Permit to Alice G. Vondrasek dba Red Hills Travel Center, Lander Route, Rawlins, WY, License No. 351, 10-7-76 to 10-7-77 and to Robert E. Metze dba Snowy Range KOA Kampground, Saratoga, WY, License No. 352, 10-7-76 to 10-7-77. There being no protests entered, the Board granted a transfer of Retail Malt Beverage Permit to Max B. Leach dba Lamont Service, Lamont, WY., License No. 353, 10-7-76 to 10-7-77.

RAWLINS-CARBON COUNTY ZONING & PLANNING. It was moved by Glode and seconded by Lemich and unanimously carried to allow the petition of D. J. Gillilan, Rawlins, WY, for a zone change from RAM (Ranching-Agriculture-Mining) to HB (Highway Business) containing approximately 24 acres of Section 18, Township 21, Range 87, Carbon County, Wyoming located south of Highway 30, east of Rawlins city limits at the Airport Road.

CARBON COUNTY MUSEUM BOARD. Members of the museum board met to discuss building plans for storage expansion adjacent to the museum.

SAVERY-POT HOOK PROJECT. David G. Wilde and Henry Drake, U. S. Bureau of Reclamation, met with the Commissioners to acquaint them with the current status of the Savery-Pot Hook Project. A summary sheet was presented and filed in the office of the County Clerk.

FUTURE ENERGY DEVELOPMENT. Gary Long and E. L. Spencer, Bureau of Land Management, discussed with the Board the impact of developments in Carbon County, taking into account ranching, wildlife and other resources affected by energy development. They stressed that the BLM wishes to promote energy production in an orderly fashion and is conducting an inventory and a study of environmental impact in order to open coal lands for public bidding as rapidly as possible.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN ENERGY. Theodore D. Browne and Ernie Mecca, representing Rocky Mountain Energy Company, presented a study of the population forecasts for Rawlins and Carbon County if the three RMC mines southwest of Rawlins are opened by 1980.

CARBON COUNTY AGENCY ON AGING. Monsignor John Meyer discussed with the Board the use of the land east of the old hospital as a possible site for a Senior Center and available funding from various sources for this project.

Thereupon the Board adjourned until the following day.

WYOMING STATE PENITENTIARY RELOCATION. State Auditor James Griffith and members of the State Board of Charities and Reform staff met with the Commissioners to discuss plans and possible sites for a new state penitentiary. The four sites under consideration are located: 1. North of Rawlins and east of U.S. 287 near the city dump. 2. Southeast of Sinclair. 3. Directly south of Rawlins in the Hay Gulch area. 4. Six
