PROPOSED INDUSTRIAL ROAD PROJECT, SHIRLEY BASIN ACCESS ROAD

Motion was made by Martin McMahon, seconded by Lemich and unanimously carried to accept the following Report of Views to County Commissioners.

REPORT OF VIEWS TO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

WE, JACK SULLIVAN, FRED CRONBERG AND JOHN P. BURKE, do hereby file written report with the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, with reference to industrial road to be established at the juncture of State Highway 75 and easterly a distance of 6.290 feet, width thirty (30) feet, through Sections 19 and 20, Township 27 North, Range 78 West, of the 6th Principal Meridian, Carbon County, Wyoming. With reference to said report pursuant to Section 27.69.6, Wyoming Statutes, 1957, we append written findings of fact with reference to the following factors:

1. Whether or not said proposed road is practicable.
2. Whether said road ought to be established.
3. Probable expense of the same including damages to property owners along the line thereof.
4. Such other matters as shall enable the Board to act according to the premises.

With reference to the above factors:

WE FIND AS FOLLOWS:

1. The improvement to said road is practicable and desireable, due to the heavy traffic of 400+ cars a day and being on a school bus route.
2. Said road should be established as a paved road.
3. No R.O.W. Damages as county now has the necessary easements.
4. In viewing, we find good grading already done, so it should not be too expensive a project.
