ESTABLISHMENT OF COUNTY ROAD NO. 2

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming (hereinafter referred to as THE BOARD) on the 6th day of June, 1978, required that the establishment procedure and vacation procedure for a road known as Part Shirley Basin Road, County Road No. 2, be commenced pursuant to Section 24-3-101; and

WHEREAS, Notice of Location was published three consecutive weeks in three consecutive issues pursuant to the statutes in such case made and provided; and

WHEREAS, the Board requested that protests and claims for damages be submitted; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received none of the same; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received right-of-way easements and agreements from all interested landowners and parties; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received a survey by William G. Ladd, Consulting Engineer, Suite 304 Western Resources Building, Casper, Wyoming of said proposed location of said road;

WHEREBY, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, deem it in the public interest to establish said road;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Part Shirley Basin Road, County Road No. 2 be established in the public interest described as follows:

A 100 ft. wide road easement being a portion of the SE¼ SE¼ Sec. 3 and NE¼ NE¼ Sec. 10, T. 27 N, R. 78 W., Carbon County, Wyoming., more particularly described as follows:

Beginning on the line between Secs. 2 and 3, T. 27 N., R. 78 W. at a point on the centerline of a 100 foot wide road easement from which the Cor. of Secs. 2,3,10 and 11 bears S. 0° 38' E., 117.2 ft. dist; Thence from the point beginning 578.5 feet along a true curve to the left having a radius of 709.2 ft. to the end of said curve; Thence S. 30° 04' W., 140.00 ft. continuing along the centerline of said road easement to the beginning of a true curve to the right; Thence along said true curve having a radius of 569.66 ft. for a distance of 627.7 ft. to the end of said curve and a point on the centerline of an existing County Road and the end of said 100 foot wide road easement;

A 100 foot wide road easement being a portion of the SW¼ SW¼ Sec. 2, T. 27 N., R. 78 W., Carbon County, Wyoming, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning on the line between Secs. 2 and 3, T. 27 N., R. 78 W. at a point on the centerline of a 100 ft. wide road easement from which the Cor. of Secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11 bears S. 0° 38' E., 117.2 ft. dist., Thence from the point of beginning 119.2 ft. along a true curve to the right having a radius of 709.2 ft. to the end of said curve; Thence N. 86° 26' E., 40.0 ft. continuing along the centerline of said road easement to the beginning of a true curve to the right; Thence along said true curve having a radius of 1744.3 ft. for a distance of 772.6 ft. to a point on the line between Secs. 2 and 11, T. 27 N., R. 78 W. and the end of said 100 ft. wide raod easement;

A 100 foot wide road easement being a portion of the NW¼ NW¼ Sec. 11, T. 27 N., R. 78 W., Carbon County, Wyoming, more particularly described as follows: Beginning on the line between Secs. 2 and 11, T. 27 N., R. 78 W. at a point on the centerline of a 100 foot wide road easement from which the W 1/16 Cor. of Secs. 2 and 11 bears N. 89° 01' E., 416.2 ft. dist.; Thence from the point of beginning 436.5 ft. along a true curve to the right having a radius of 1744.3 ft. to the end of said true curve; Thence continuing along the centerline of said road easement on a true curve to the right having a radius of 459.0 ft. for a distance of 51.0 ft. to a point on the East line of said NW¼ NW¼ Sec. 11 and the end of said 100 ft. wide road easement;

A 100 ft. wide road easement being a portion of the NE¼ NW¼ Sec. 11, T. 27 N., R. 78 W., Carbon County, Wyoming, more particularly described as follows: Beginning on the West line of said NE¼ NW¼ Sec. 11, T. 27 N., R. 78 W. at a point on the centerline of a 100 foot wide road easement from which the W 1/16 Cor. of Secs. 2 and 11 bears N. 0° 57' W., 250.4 ft. dist.; Thence from the point of beginning 326.2 ft. along a true curve to the right having a radius 459.0 ft. to the end of said true curve; Thence S. 6° 46' E., 200.0 ft. continuing along the centerline of said road easement to the beginning of a true to the left; Thence along said true curve to the left having a radius of 202.2 ft. for a distance of 258.1 ft. to a point on the centerline of an existing County Road and the end of said 100 foot wide road easement.

Note: The above bearings refer to the Wyoming State Plane Coordinate System, East Central Zone.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said existing County Road from the point of beginning of the new established road to the point of ending of the new established road is hereby vacated.

SALE OF LEASED MEDICAL EQUIPMENT

The Commissioners reviewed the leases of MFT Leasing Company and Bennett Leasing Company of Salt Lake City. After due deliberation it was moved by Commissioner Lemich and unanimously carried that Carbon County, Wyoming purchase out right all personal property and both leases which are as follows:

MFT Leasing Company amount due is \$9,419.67. Bennett Leasing Company amount due is \$5,464.23.

It was further moved by Commissioner McMahon and unanimously carried that Dr. Klein be sold the personal property in said leases and now in his possession for the sum of \$9,500. That said sum is due payable at the rate of \$500 per month on the 10th of each and every month hereafter for a period of 19 consecutive months until said principal sum is paid in full. Monthly installments which remain unpaid after the 10th of the month will bear interest at the rate of 9% per annum. It was moved by Commissioner Glode and unanimously carried that Dr.'s Zaulkin and Chaudrey be sold the medical equipment in their possession for the sum of \$2,203.18, which sum is due payable in full one year from this date. It was further moved by Commissioner McMahon and unanimously carried that Jeffrey R. Balison, M.D., be awarded the medical equipment in his possession for the sum of \$397.16 and that a Bill of Sale be executed and delivered to him forewith upon payment in full.

OLD JUNIOR HIGH BUILDING (COURTHOUSE ANNEX)

The Commissioners met with the School District No. 1 Board of Trustees to discuss the joint use of the old Junior High building. An architectural survey will be made to determine the feasibility and cost of renovation of the building to accomodate office space for both the School District and the County. Some of the uses proposed included School District No. 1 Central Office, Carbon County Public Library, the Agent's office, Public Defender, Carbon County Planning & Zoning Commission, Council of Governments office space, County Surveyor and storage space for county records.

MUDDY CREEK BRIDGE
