The ambulance they have now is totally undependable, requiring \$700.00 worth of repairs in 10 months. Encampment is the farthest community from the Hospital in Rawlins, but has the most runs per capita. The Commissioners took the matter under advisement.

CARBON COUNTY AGING BOARD

John K. Ressler submitted his resignation from the Carbon County Aging Board, effective February 7, 1978.

CARBON COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION, BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Russell Herring was reappointed to another term on the Fair Board. His term will run from 2/1/78 to 2/1/83.

SARATOGA-CARBON COUNTY JOINT POWERS BOARD

Slim Freeburg was reappointed to another term on the Saratoga-Carbon County Joint Powers Board. His term will run from 2/1/78 to 2/1/79.

HANNA-ELMO OUTDOOR RECREATION BOARD

In a meeting with Ron Hood, the Commissioners agreed to assist the Hanna-Elmo Outdoor Recreation Board with surveying costs for a recreation park in the Hanna vicinity.

CARBON COUNTY CIVIL DEFENSE

C. A. Bergstrand, the Rawlins Civil Defense Coordinator was present to discuss the upcoming meeting in Laramie between the E.P.O. (Emergency Preparedness Operation) and the Governor. The motion was made by Commissioner McMahon, seconded by Commissioner Lemich and unanimously carried to appoint Mr. Bergstrand Deputy County Civil Defense Coordinator at \$100.00 per month and expenses.

The meeting was adjourned until the following day.

JUSTICE COURT

Margie Meacham, Rawlins Justice of the Peace, appeared to report to the Commissioners on the increasing workload in her office and the need for more space. The commissioners discussed with her the possibility of future expansion of the court.

PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICER

Dr. R. C. Tongco submitted his resignation as County Health Officer effective February 28, 1978. Dr. Daniel S. Klein was appointed to fill the position effective March 1, 1978.

SHIRLEY BASIN ROAD

Motion was made by Commissioner Lemich, seconded by Commissioner McMahon and unanimously carried to authorize the County Attorney's Office to accept the sum of \$5,000.00 from Uranium Supply Services Corp. for alteration of the County road at Shirley Basin.

COLLEGE OF HUMAN MEDICINE

The Commissioners unanimously passed a resolution urging the Wyoming legislature to support funding for the continued development of the College of Human Medicine at the University of Wyoming.

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ELECTION DISTRICT AND PRECINCT BOUNDARIES

The Election District Resolution was read in full. Then it was moved by Commissioner McMahon, seconded by Commissioner Lemich and unanimously carried that the Resolution establishing and finalizing Election District and Precinct Boundaries be adopted and filed of record in the office of the County Clerk.

CARBON COUNTY ELECTION DISTRICT AND PRECINCT BOUNDARIES

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 22.1-113, Wyoming Statutes 1957, as amended, provides that the Board of Commissioners at its regular February meeting in every General Election year shall divide the County into not more than thirty (30) election precincts; and

WHEREAS, the proposed changes and establishment of precinct election boundaries have been heretofore published in a newspaper of general circulation in Carbon County, Wyoming, as by law required;

WHEREAS, Section 22.1-114, Wyoming Statutes, 1957, as amended, provides that a proposed change in election precinct boundary may be finalized by the Board of County Commissioners at its regular February meeting and that each precinct shall be designated by number; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, finds that the election district and precinct boundaries as hereinafter set forth are conducive to the best interests and convenience of the greatest number of electors involved and said boundaries should be finalized and established as hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming:

1. That the election precincts and boundaries as hereinafter set forth be, and the same are hereby established within Carbon County, Wyoming.

2. That the County Clerk of Carbon County, Wyoming, be, and she is hereby authorized and directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to:

All that territory embraced within the following Townships shall be known as Election District 1 Precinct 1 - Rawlins: That part of Sections 15 and 19, Township 21 North, Range 87 West, 6th P.M., lying outside the Rawlins city limits and south of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way; that part of Sections 16 and 17, Township 21 North, Range 87 West, 6th P.M., lying within the Rawlins city limits and south of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way; Sections 20 and 21, all of which lie inside Rawlins city limits and Sections 22 through 36, all of which lie outside the Rawlins city limits, Township 21 North, Range 87 West, 6th P.M., all of Townships 19 and 20 North, Range 86 West, 6th P.M., all of Townships 17, 18, 19 and 20 North, Range 87 West, 6th P.M.; all Townships 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 North and that part of Township 21 North lying south of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way, Range 88 West, 6th P.M.; all of Townships 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 North and that part of Township 21 North lying south of the Union Pacific right-of-way, Range 89 West, 6th P.M.; all of Townships 16, 17, 18 and 19 North and all of Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, 35 and 36, Township 20 North, Range 90 West, 6th P.M., all being in Carbon County.
