Section 1. That the Chairman and Board of County Commissioners shall accept the amendment to the grant agreement between the City of Rawlins, County of Carbon, and the Rawlins-Carbon County Airport Board, Wyoming and the United States of America.

Section 2. That the Chairman and Board of County Commissioners are hereby authorized to execute said amendment to the grant agreement on behalf of the County of Carbon, Wyoming, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to impress thereon the official seal of the County of Carbon, Wyoming and to attest said execution.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO GRANT AGREEMENT FOR PROJECT NO. 5-56-0023-01

WHEREAS, The Federal Aviation Administration (hereinafter referred to as the "FAA") has determined it to be in the interest of the United States that the grant agreement between the FAA acting for and on behalf of the United States, and the City of Rawlins, County of Carbon, and the Rawlins-Carbon County Airport Board, Wyoming (hereinafter referred to as the "sponsor"), accepted by said sponsor on the 26th day of April, 1979 be amended as hereinafter provided.

NOW THEREFORE, WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of the benefits to accrue to the parties hereto, the FAA on behalf of the United States, on the one part, and the sponsor, on the other part, do hereby mutually agree that the described airport development now included in said grant agreement be deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

Extend and mark Runway 4/22 from 5,500' x 100' to 7,000 x 100' including turnaround Runway 22, and including grading to 8,300'; remove existing lighting and install MIRL, Runway 4/22, 7,000 l.f., including VASI-2 system, both ends of Runway 4/22; place single bituminous seal coat on existing runway and runway extension; install lighted wind cone and segmented circle; grade and provide drainage control for transition from existing Runway 4/22 to future turf crosswind Runway 10/28; seeding.

It is hereby understood and agreed that the maximum obligation of the United States as set forth in the terms and conditions of said grant agreement on page 2 paragraph 1, is hereby increased from \$762,996 to \$813,921.
