LIMITED RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSE

A hearing for the issuance of a Limited Retail Liquor License to Lucas, Sarri, McAtee, VFW, Post 6680, Hanna, Wyoming, having been heard at 11:00 A.M., April 4, 1984, was denied issuance by the Commissioners because of the liquor license moratorium which was adopted by the Commissioners beginning January 1, 1984 and ending December 31, 1984.

SARATOGA LIBRARY

A motion was made by York, seconded by Grieve and unanimously carried to accept the bid of Welton Construction, Inc., Saratoga, Wyoming. The amount being \$228,450.00 which includes alternates No. 3 and 4. for the construction of the Saratoga Library.

COUNTY ROAD 605

A hearing was held at 2:00 P.M. to hear objections to the vacation of the last two miles of County Road 605. Written objections to the vacation of two miles of County Road 605 were reviewed by the Commissioners. Discussion for and against the vacation were also heard.

A motion was then made by York, seconded by Grieve and unanimously carried to table the vacating procedures pending further review.

CARBON COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE

The specifications having been met, a motion was made by York, seconded by Grieve and unanimously carried to accept the bid of Big "R" Manufacturing & Distributing, Inc. for bridge repairs. The amount being \$34,067.17.

CARBON COUNTY PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

A motion was made by York, seconded by Grieve and unanimously carried to approve Case 83-15.

Case No. 83-15 - Variance - Seminoe Boat Club, Box 182, Rawlins, WY 82301. Variance to the Carbon County Subdivision Regulations, section 5.02.05 for the proposed Bunker's Cove Subdivision to allow for a 35 foot right-of-way on interior streets.
