DISASTER DECLARATION

WHEREAS, Carbon County suffered damage to roads, bridges, culverts, headgates, fences, farmlands, homes, other farm buildings, business, and other public facilities, caused by extremely high waters from melting of above normal snow pack. Snow melt beginning early in month of May. This high water far exceeds any previous flood plain level. And;


WHEREAS, the cost of clean-up, repair, and replacement is far in excess of county resources available;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Carbon County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, declare Carbon County a disaster area.
