DESIGNATION OF DEPOSITORIES

A motion was made by Lemich, seconded by York and unanimously carried to designate all Federal and State Chartered Banks and Savings and Loans in Carbon County with FDIC and FSLIC approval as County Depositories.

CARBON COUNTY PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

A motion was made by York, seconded by Lemich and unanimously carried to adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION 1984 - 1

WHEREAS, on December 4, 1968, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, adopted a resolution creating the Carbon County Planning and Zoning Commission; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that resolution, members of the Carbon County Planning and Zoning Commission were appointed for 5-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the statutes of the State of Wyoming provide for 3-year terms instead of 5-year terms;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the resolution creating the Carbon County Planning and Zoning Commission passed by the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, on December 4, 1968, be, and the same is hereby amended to provide that the Carbon County Planning and Zoning Commission shall be composed of five members as hereinafter set forth for a term of office set opposite each name:

1. Robert F. Konrath	Walcott	Three Year Term
2. Bill Cooper	Medicine Bow	One Year Term
3. Jim Berger	Saratoga	Two Year Term
4. Harry Russell	Dixon	Two Year Term
5. Neal Kirk	Rawlins	Three Year Term

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of office of each of said members shall be deemed to have commenced on the 4th day of December, 1983, and continue thereafter until their successors are duly appointed and qualified.

CUTTER RACES - CALCUTTA WAGERING

Pursuant to Section 6-7-101 Wyo. A motion was made by Lemich, seconded by York and unanimously carried to reappoint Leo Chapman to the board for a five year term beginning February 1, 1984 and ending February 1, 1989.

FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING

NOTICE
POLICY OF NONDISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF
HANDICAPPED STATUS

The County of Carbon does not discriminate on the basis of handicapped status in the admission or access to, or treatment or employment in, its programs or activities.

Mary G. Bradford, County Clerk, P. O. Box 6, Rawlins, Wyoming, has been designated to coordinate compliance with the nondiscrimination requirements contained in section 51.55 of the revenue sharing regulations.

In providing the initial notification the County will use the newspaper, radio and post notices in public places by January 17, 1984.
