CARBON COUNTY ROAD 291

A motion was made by York and seconded by Daily and unanimously carried to execute the following contract agreement:

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

This agreement entered into this 7th day of May, 1985, by and between the Carbon County Board of County Commissioners (owners) and Sims Corporation.

The Contractor agrees to perform the necessary work to complete the Hot Bituminous paving of 1.9 miles of Carbon County Road 291 North of Hanna, Wyoming. The work is to include by is not limited to furnish all material, labor and equipment to provide a complete paving job on said County road.

The work is to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications and the standard industry practices now in effect or use. The plans specifications and conditions all of which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by the reference.

The Contractor agrees to furnish a 100% performance bond and a 100% payment bond within ten (10) days after receiving written notice of award.

All work is to be warranted for one (1) year from date of final acceptance and the performance bond shall remain in effect for this time period.

The work to be performed under this agreement shall commence within ten (10) days after written notice to proceed has been received, and be completed by July 31st, 1985.

The owner(s) shall pay the Contractor the total sum of \$265,704.25 subject to additions and deductions by change orders as provided in the General Conditions and upon determination of final quantities.

The owner shall receive liquidated damages in the amount of \$100.00 per day for all time in excess of the contract time.

Progress payments shall be made every month with the payment being 90% of the work completed for the period billed.

Final payment with retainage shall be forty-four (44) days after completion and acceptance by the Carbon County Engineering - Road and Bridge Department, subject to the applicable state law on such disbursements.

UNIVERSITY EXTENSION AGENT

A motion was made by Daily and seconded by York and unanimously carried to execute the following agreement:

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the University of Wyoming, hereafter referred to as the University, and the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, hereafter referred to as the County.

WITNESSETH: That whereas, it is desired by the County to employ, under the Federal Smith Lever Act and the State Acceptance Act of 1915 and amendments thereto covering Extension Work in Agriculture and Home Economics, a University Extension Agent for the purpose of assisting and encouraging the general development of educational programs throughout Carbon County, & that said work shall be done and directed under the supervision of the Associate Director of the Agricultural Extension Service of the University of Wyoming;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements of each to the other running, and for other good and valuable consideration, as herein contained, the said parties agree as follows:

That each party to this agreement shall contribute annually to support the work, the cash sum, equipment and services indicated by the following schedule:

COOPERATING PARTIES	CASH CONTRIBUTIONS FOR:
University of Wyoming Agricultural Extension Service	\$16,704.00 Salary (includes fringe benefits)

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County of Carbon

\$10,320.00 Salary Plus Support

The County agrees to make its contribution to the University. The University will in turn make total disbursement of salary to the University Extension Agent being employed in the county.

Final payment of the annual contribution from the County must be received by the University prior to June 30 of each year.

In order that the University may receive the total County contributions for each fiscal year before June 30 of such year, the County agrees to make payment to the University as follows:

Four equal quarterly payments by August 10, November 10, February 10, and May 10.

THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT shall be and remain in force and effect from July 1, 1985 until June 30, 1986 unless terminated by mutual consent of the two parties involved.

In event this position becomes temporarily vacant the unused funds contributed by the County will be credited toward salary for a replacement; if the agreement is terminated the unused funds will be refunded to the County by the University.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, has caused this agreement to be executed by its Chairman on this 7th day of May, 1985, and the University of Wyoming has caused the same to be executed by the President of the University of Wyoming on this ____ day of _____, 19__.
