A motion was made by Daily and seconded by Grieve to allow \$6900.00 for the payment of rent for the Play and Learning Center in Saratoga, Wyoming.

CARBON POWER & LIGHT

Guy Charles and Ron Harker, representatives of Carbon Power & Light, presented the following outline for an Economic and Industrial Survey:

County Profile

A collection of basic County data obtained through the cooperative efforts of County leaders, Community leaders and Carbon Power & Light, Inc.

This data will be analyzed by the Computer Center of Basin Electric Power Cooperative (one of Carbon's power supply cooperatives).

Data will be collected from all the communities in Carbon's service area and combined to produce a system-wide profile.

This service is at no cost to the County.

Purpose and Results

County Planners will be provided with a one-source tool containing basic information on all factors of the community structure, such as: population, housing, taxes, labor supply, business and natural resource availability, etc.

Profile will contain accurate and timely information that can be easily updated.

The interpretation of data by Basin will indicate strengths, weaknesses, trends, and potential of the County.

This service will give the County the information they need to select the best goals, objectives, and activities.

Carbon can use this information to provide the most efficient management to its members.

Carbon will use information to develop rate strategy to encourage the efficient use of electricity.
