DIXON AIRPORT

Jim Sirhall of Muller, Sirhall and Associates, Inc., engineers for the Dixon Airport project met with the Commissioners.

A motion was made by York and seconded by Daily to execute the Grant offer from F.A.A. for \$350,000.00 (to rehabilitate, widen to 60', and mark runway 6/24; remove powerline obstruction; install segmented circle and wind cone) and the Wyoming Aeronautics Commission Grant for \$119,620.00 (to rehabilitate & widen runway 6/24 to 60', rehabilitate taxiways & aprons, mark all paved surfaces. Install a wind cone & segmented circle. Bury a portion of power line. Relocate fencing. Seed airport areas disturbed by construction.) and Wyoming Aeronautics Commission Grant for \$46,020.00 (to install runway lighting & rotating beacon; install lighting for the wind cone) and to execute a contract agreement with Sims Corp. for the project bid price of \$449,187.00.

Roll was called with the following results: Grieve, aye; York, aye; Daily, aye.

March 19, 1985

A motion was made by Daily and seconded by York and unanimously carried to execute an Avigation Easement Agreement with Duncan Livestock Company.

A motion was made by Daily, seconded by York & unanimously carried to execute an Addendum to Agreement Between Sponsor and Engineer for Professional Services between Carbon County and Muller, Sirhall and Associates, Inc. The agreement is on file in the office of the County Clerk.

WYOMING DEFERRED COMPENSATION INC.

Wayne Case, a representative of Wyoming Deferred Compensation Inc. met with the Commissioners to present a pre-tax savings plan that is available to the County through payroll deduction. The Commissioners took the proposal under advisement.

CARBON COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE

Frank Smith, road supervisor presented a report of his department to the Commissioners.

The Commissioners approved the renewal of permit SG-1443 with the State of Wyoming for the removal of sand & gravel from the following described land: 40.00 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T.20N., R81W. of the 6th P.M. The term of the permit is for two years beginning December 5, 1984 to December 5, 1986. The County agrees to pay fifty cents per ton.

CARBON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES

A motion was made by York and seconded by Daily and unanimously carried to execute the following declaration:

DISASTER DECLARATION

Resolution #1985-3

WHEREAS, The Village of Lamont has suffered the loss of their water supply due to contamination. The well has been closed by the EPA until the source of contamination can be traced, and the situation remedied.

WHEREAS, the cost of drilling a new well or hauling water until a new source of water is available is in excess of finances or resources available at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the board of County Commissioners for Carbon County, Wyoming declare this to be a disaster area.
