COUNTY CLERK

RADIO TECHNICIAN

Clayton Kilgore, radio technician for Carbon County requested two car radios for the Sheriff. A motion was made by Daily, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to allow the purchase.

CARBON BUILDING

Wade Waldrip, civil attorney for Carbon County presented a lease agreement for office space in the Carbon Building. A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Daily and unanimously carried to execute the office lease between Carbon County and the Carbon County Substance Abuse Task Force.

ROAD & BRIDGE

Frank Smith, Carbon County road supervisor gave his report to the Board for the month of November, 1988. Also discussed was the possibility of purchasing a personal computer for inventory control and equipment maintenance records at the Rawlins Road & Bridge Shop. Several scrapers are needing major repairs; the budget was analyzed to determine the monetary options available for repair or lease.

Many interested persons from different factions were in attendance to express their concerns regarding the remodeling in the Courthouse to provide a fire exit for the top floor of the building.

EXTENSION OFFICE

Marilyn Toellner, Carbon County Extension Agent reported on the condition of an extension vehicle which has 112,000 miles on it. A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Daily and carried to call for bids on a new vehicle.

PLANNING

Susan Grafton, County Planner gave her administrative report for the month of November 1988.

A motion was made by Daily, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to appoint Harry Russell III to a three (3) year term on the Carbon County Planning and Development Board beginning December 4, 1988 and ending December 4, 1991.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Sherrod France, Carbon County Economic Development Corp. representative reported on the various ongoing projects of the corporation.

FIRE DEPARTMENT


Joe Remick, member of the Encampment Fire Department and the Carbon County Volunteer Fire Department asked for funding to purchase a multi-channel radio and a portable pump to be used by the Encampment Fire Department. Dan Schinkel, Carbon County Fire Chief will be consulted concerning available funds in the Fire Department budget.


PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES
