LIQUOR LICENSE FEE

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Daily and unanimously carried to adopt the following:

R E S O L U T I O N 1 9 8 8 - 4

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR EXPIRATION OF ALL LIQUOR LICENSES, MALT BEVERAGE PERMITS, AND CATERING PREMITS ISSUED AFTER JUNE 21, 1988, AND PROVIDING FOR LICENSE FEES, AND REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITHE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon:

That fees for retail liquor licenses, limited retail liquor licenses, restaurant liquor licenses, and twenty-four hour malt beverage permits and catering permits shall be as follows:

Retail Liquor License	\$1,000.00
Limited Retail Liquor License	\$ 750.00
County Retail Malt Beverage Permit	\$ 300.00
Restaurant Liquor License	\$1,000.00
Twenty-four Hour Malt Beverage Permit	\$ 10.00
Catering Permit	\$ 10.00

The above fees shall apply for all licenses issued after June 21, 1988.


HEALTH INSURANCE
