COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT

A public hearing was held at 10:00 a.m. to receive requests for Community Services Block Grant funds. K.I.D.S., Inc. presented a proposal for the building of a crisis center for children at an estimated cost of \$249,802. No further requests were received.

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Wille and passed to support the application of K.I.D.S., Inc. for the Community Services Block Grant funds. The following resolution was executed:

R E S O L U T I O N 1 9 8 9 - 5

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION BY THE CARBON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE 1989 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AND CERTIFYING THAT ALL PUBLIC PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET.

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners has determined that establishing a permanent long-term and crisis center for kids in distressed situations, and which children are often victims of domestic violence and at-risk environments, meets a serious community need and as such is hereby designated as a goal for 1989-90; and

WHEREAS, K.I.D.S., Inc. has been successful in addressing these needs; and

WHEREAS, the County has held a public hearing on the possible uses of CDBG funds on July 19, 1989 at 10:00 a.m., in the County Commissioners Chambers, Carbon County Courthouse in Rawlins, Wyoming and taken public input; and

WHEREAS, The County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, has directed its staff to prepare an application for Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount of \$249,802.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Carbon County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, approves the submission of this grant application to the State of Wyoming and further certifies that all public participation requirements have been met.

A Zone Change on two parcels formally zoned RD-1 (Residential Development - 1 acre) to RB (Retail Business) to allow for these parcels to be used for business purposes on land legally described as Lot 2, Block 2 and Lot 1, Block 3, Ryan Park 2nd Addition, in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 28, Township 16 North, Range 81 West, Carbon County, Wyoming.
