Custodian, Ernie Cruz requested a part-time person for yard clean-up at the Courthouse. The Board approved the hiring of a part-time temporary person for five months only.

CARBON BUILDING

At Bud Greene's request, the Board approved reroofing the Carbon Building at a cost of \$60,000.00.

SHERIFF

Sheriff, Don Sherrod discussed financing and personnel in the Jail and Sheriff's departments. The Sheriff also reported on grant monies available for drug related law-enforcement.

NATIONAL RECREATION AREA

Sue Bromley and Alex Semryck appeared before the Board requesting the County's support in obtaining "National Recreation Area" status. The support asked for is written as well as monetary.

INSURANCE

Bret Hillier explained the Section 89 law concerning employee benefits and reported on the savings incurred by the County through the self insurance plan versus the former Blue Cross-Blue Shield plan.

ROAD & BRIDGE

Patty Schuler, office manager reported on various activities in the Road & Bridge Department. Covered in the report were possible road clean-up by inmate work crews from the Penitentiary, fuel bids, Edward M. Nicholson vs. Carbon County Road & Bridge Notice of Dismissal and Union Pacific correspondence.

Barry Patterson, mechanic for the Road & Bridge Department gave various options for

scraper repairs. The Commissioners approved motor repairs on the scraper (unit 6141) through Wyoming Diesel Service at a cost of \$5,613.87.

Don Neuman, Construction Supervisor for the Road & Bridge Department discussed graveling the Seminoe Dam road and also gravel work done at the Fairgrounds. Damage costs on County Road 401 as a result of construction of the Rawlins pipeline were reviewed. Neuman updated the Board on Farm to Market projects and scheduled Carbon County projects.

Don Neuman, Chairman of the Road & Bridge Department Safety Committee presented a "Comprehensive Health & Safety Program" for possible adoption by the Board. The Board approved the "Program" as presented.

GREEN MOUNTAIN RECREATION COMMITTEE

A formal letter was received by the Board from the Green Mountain Recreation Committee requesting \$36,000.00 from the County for a feasibility study of a winter recreation site at Green Mountain, southwest of Encampment.

HANNA RECREATION CENTER

The Hanna Recreation Center requested funding for fiscal year 1989-1990 in the amount of \$50,000.00. The request will be considered.


HANNA JOINT POWERS BOARD

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Wille and passed to appoint Richard Kinder to the unexpired term of Lorin Young on the Hanna Joint Powers Board beginning April 18, 1989 and ending November 1, 1990.


WYOMING MACHINERY
