PLANNING

A meeting was held with the Planning Commission in the Carbon Building. Tom Campbell Deputy County Attorney, explained the laws that rule planning.

CORONER

County Coroner, Curt Rostad talked about the Coroner's vehicle, explaining possible ways to replace it: 1. buy a new vehicle; 2. buy a used mortuary vehicle; 3. pay him mileage on mortuary vehicles.

Rostad will close the Coroner's building located in the Rawlins Road & Bridge yard, and wants to rent his mortuary building for \$100.00 a month. Rostad also talked about increasing indigent burial costs to \$1,460.00.

PLAY AND LEARNING

Lee Sherman and Melody Posey-Harris of the Play and Learning Center in Saratoga discussed a letter sent to the Commissioners from their organization requesting \$15,000.00. The Commissioners took the request under advisement and will get back to the Play and Learning Center in January, 1991.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE

Shirley Martinez, Sue Ellis and Tom Fitzgerald want the Commissioners to declare the week of December 9 - 15, 1990 as Drunk and Drugged Driving Awareness Week in Carbon County, Wyoming.

County Civil Attorney, Wade Waldrip went through the personnel policies and practices with the Commissioners.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Dwight France of the Carbon County Fire Department, asked for approval to purchase a 6x6 tanker for \$15,000.00. The Commissioners will look into the possibility.

John MacPherson, Kermit Brown and Judge Larry Lehman said they need more money for the law library.

ROAD & BRIDGE

Don Neuman and Patty Schuler met with the Commissioners. Schuler talked about a solid waste program that she attended. Neuman reported on the damage to County Road 401 from the construction of the City of Rawlins water line. A \$6466.82 check should be on the way. Snider Oil wants to sell some pipe at \$.45 a foot. Neuman wants to build cattle guards. The Commissioners said to buy the pipe.

BAGGS SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL DISTRICT

A motion was made by Wille, seconded by Graalman and carried to appoint Ed Reed of Baggs to the Baggs Solid Waste Disposal District.
