Landowner, George Brox asked the Commissioners about land south of Rawlins and the cash value of an easement to his land. County civil attorney, Wade Waldrip told him some ways to solve his problems.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

A motion was made by Wille, seconded by Graalman and carried to move into executive session. (9:20 a.m.)

A motion was made by Wille, seconded by Graalman and carried to come out of executive session. (10:20 a.m.)

SPECIAL COMMITTEE

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Wille and carried to establish a special committee to answer the management letter from auditors McGladrey & Pullen. Teddy Yockey was appointed chairman of the committee. The other members of the committee will be Cindy Baldwin, Rubyalice Ross, Patty Schuler, Ivy Pennington and Marilyn Bradford.

ABANDONED VEHICLE TOWING

Don Cuin, the owner of Wyoming Towing expressed his concern of not being called by the Sheriff's office for his share of County towing business. He wants the Board to look into this problem. Mr. Cuin also believes all people having vehicles in the impound yard are not charged for towing and storage.

County Sheriff, Don Sherrod addressed Mr. Cuin's concerns. Wyoming Towing rates are higher than the other towing companies being used by the County. All owners of vehicles that are towed and stored in the County impound yard are charged for these expenses. Only vehicles towed and stored for evidence are exempt from the charges.

SHERIFF

County Sheriff, Don Sherrod reported on inmates presently in California and Texas that need to be brought back to Rawlins. The State of Wyoming will share the expense of returning one of the inmates in California.

PLANNING

County Planner, Susan Grafton gave her administrative report for the month of January 1990 and updated the Commissioners on her land use program. Also discussed was a solid waste landfill.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Economic Development Corporation representatives, Mike Hickman and Bob Dahl reported on the Sand Lake Lodge program and the proposal for the location of a medium security prison in the City of Rawlins.

TAX LAND

A bid opening was held at 2:30 p.m. for the transfer of tax land at Aspen Meadow. A bid of \$1,158.00 was received from Jim Wells and a bid of \$1,201.00 was received from Tom Hornbeck. A motion was made by Wille, seconded by Graalman and carried to accept the high bid of \$1,201.00 from Tom Hornbeck.

CARBON BUILDING

A motion was made by Wille, seconded by Graalman and carried to renew the contract for cleaning services at the Carbon Building. The contract between Carbon County and Nick's Cleaning Service was executed.
