COMMISSIONER'S PROCEEDINGS

REGULAR MEETING

July 2, 1991

The Board met at 9:00 a.m. Commissioners Art Zeiger, Gary Graalman and Linda Fleming were present. Art Zeiger, Chairman.

MINUTES of the regular meeting of June 18, 1991 were read and approved.

FINANCIAL REPORTS of the County Officers were audited and placed on file.

SHERIFF

County Sheriff Chet Engstrom discussed buying some cars, but needed one car immediately. No action was taken.

PUBLIC HEALTH

Sherrie Patch, Public Health Nurse and the Commissioners conducted a public hearing on the proposed use of Community Services Block Grant Funds for the period September 1, 1991 through August 30, 1992.

A motion was made by Fleming, seconded by Graalman and unanimously carried to sign an application for Community Services Block Grant funding for emergency health care in the amount of \$28,294.00.

Sherrie Patch also requested the Commissioners enter into a contract with Nursing Services, Wyoming State Division of Health & Medical Services including Carbon County Public Health Nursing Service and Northwest Colorado Visiting Nurse Association, a non-profit association incorporated in Colorado. No action was taken.

CARBON COUNTY VICTIM WITNESS PROGRAM

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Fleming and unanimously carried to enter into an agreement between Carbon County, the Sheriff of Carbon County and Marcy Craig for the purpose of serving as the Carbon County Victim Witness Program Coordinator.

PLANNING

Nina Adams gave her administrator's report for the month of June. This was her first one for the Planning Commission. Adams asked to go to the Western Planner Conference in Lincoln, Nebraska at a cost of \$566.00. The meeting is scheduled for July 31 thru August 2, 1991.

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Fleming and unanimously carried to send Nina Adams to the conference for no more than \$566.00.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Bob Dahl, representing the Carbon County Economic Development Corp. presented his strategic plan for the corporation from 1991 through 1994.

ROAD & BRIDGE

A motion was made by Graalman, seconded by Fleming and unanimously carried to send a letter to Joseph Yovich of the Wyoming Highway Department, asking to amend the original SC-CFM Project #6-33.

CARBON BUILDING

Patty Schuler reported on the Carbon Building repairs.
